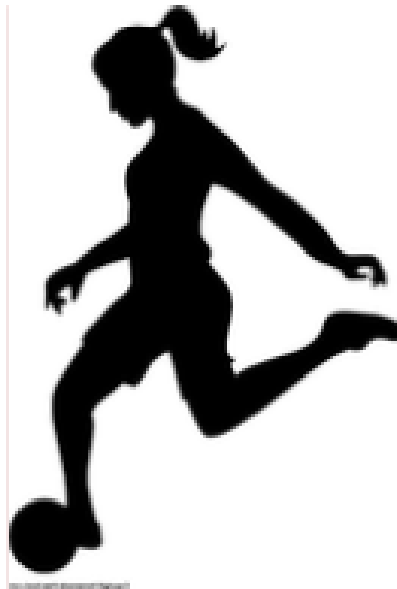
Essex County Trails & Sails

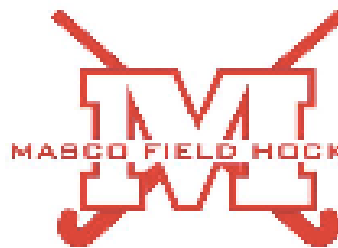
